AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. BENNET Viz:

1 After section 8404, insert the following:

2 SEC. 8405. WATERSHED CONDITION FRAMEWORK.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title III of the Healthy Forests
4 Restoration Act of 2003 (16 U.S.C. 6541 et seq.) (as
5 amended by section 8404(a)) is amended by adding at the
6 end the following:

## 7 "SEC. 304. WATERSHED CONDITION FRAMEWORK.

8 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Agriculture, 9 acting through the Chief of the Forest Service (referred 10 to in this section as the 'Secretary'), shall establish and 2

maintain a Watershed Condition Framework for National
Forest System land—
"(1) to evaluate and classify the condition of
watersheds, taking into consideration—
"(A) water quality and quantity;
"(B) aquatic habitat and biota;
"(C) riparian and wetland vegetation;
"(D) the presence of roads and trails;
"(E) soil type and condition;
"(F) groundwater-dependent ecosystems;
"(G) relevant terrestrial indicators, such as
fire regime, risk of catastrophic fire, forest and
rangeland vegetation, invasive species, and in-
sects and disease; and
"(H) other significant factors, as deter-
mined by the Secretary;
"(2) to identify for protection and restoration
up to 5 priority watersheds in each National Forest,
and up to $2$ priority watersheds in each national
grassland, taking into consideration the impact of
the condition of the watershed condition on-
"(A) wildfire behavior;
"(B) flood risk;
"(C) fish and wildlife;
"(D) drinking water supplies;

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1	"(E) irrigation water supplies;
2	"(F) forest-dependent communities; and
3	"(G) other significant impacts, as deter-
4	mined by the Secretary;
5	"(3) to develop a watershed protection and res-
6	toration action plan for each priority watershed
7	that—
8	"(A) takes into account existing restora-
9	tion activities being implemented in the water-
10	shed; and
11	"(B) includes, at a minimum—
12	"(i) the major stressors responsible
13	for the impaired condition of the water-
14	shed;
15	"(ii) a set of essential projects that,
16	once completed, will address the identified
17	stressors and improve watershed condi-
18	tions;
19	"(iii) a proposed implementation
20	schedule;
21	"(iv) potential partners and funding
22	sources; and
23	"(v) a monitoring and evaluation pro-
24	gram;

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1	"(4) to prioritize protection and restoration ac-
2	tivities for each watershed restoration action plan;
3	"(5) to implement each watershed protection
4	and restoration action plan; and
5	"(6) to monitor the effectiveness of protection
6	and restoration actions and indicators of watershed
7	health.
8	"(b) COORDINATION.—In carrying out subsection
9	(a), the Secretary shall—
10	"(1) coordinate with interested non-Federal
11	landowners and State, Tribal, and local governments
12	within the relevant watershed; and
13	"(2) provide for an active and ongoing public
14	engagement process.
15	"(c) EMERGENCY DESIGNATION.—Notwithstanding
16	paragraph (2) of subsection (a), the Secretary may iden-
17	tify a watershed as a priority for rehabilitation in the Wa-
18	tershed Condition Framework without using the process
19	described in that subsection if a Forest Supervisor deter-
20	mines that—
21	((1) a wildfire has significantly diminished the
22	condition of the watershed; and
23	"(2) the emergency stabilization activities of the
24	Burned Area Emergency Response Team are insuffi-
25	cient to return the watershed to proper function.".

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(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The table of con tents for the Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003 (16
 U.S.C. 6501 note; Public Law 108–148) (as amended by
 section 8404(b)) is amended by inserting after the item
 relating to section 303 the following:

"Sec. 304. Watershed Condition Framework.".
