8	"(i) Local agricultural business	
9	PROJECT.—The term 'local agricultural	
10	business project' means a project that is—	
11	"(I) designed to promote the pro-	
12	duction of a locally or regionally pro-	
13	duced food; and	

1	"(II) located on 1 or more prop-
2	erty lots (regardless of the location of
3	the property lot), the cumulative acre-
4	age of which is more than 1/4 acre.
5	"(ii) Local food entrepreneur.—
6	The term 'local food entrepreneur' means
7	an individual or group of individuals who
8	carry out a local agricultural business
9	project.
10	"(iii) Locally or regionally pro-
11	DUCED FOOD.—The term 'locally or re-
12	gionally produced food' means any food
13	that is raised, planted, or produced in—
14	"(I) the locality or region in
15	which the food is marketed, such that
16	the total distance that the food is
17	transported is less than 400 miles
18	from the location at which the food is
19	raised, planted, or produced; or
20	"(II) the State in which the food
21	is raised, planted, or produced."; and

23	"(xi) Underserved community.—
24	The term 'underserved community' means
25	a community (including an urban or rural

1	community and an Indian tribal commu-
2	nity) that, as determined by the Secretary,

4	"(I) limited access to affordable,

6	and vegetables, in grocery retail stores
7	or farmer-to-consumer direct markets;

9	"(II) a high rate of hunger or

15	"(D) LOCAL OR REGIONAL AGRICULTURAL

17	"(i) In General.—The Secretary
18	shall make loans to microentrepreneurial
19	development organizations for the purpose
20	of providing low fixed-interest rate loans to
21	local food entrepreneurs to assist in car-
22	rying out local agricultural business
23	projects.
24	"(ii) Eligible activities.—Loans
25	made under clause (i) may be used by the

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1	local food entrepreneur to carry out eligible
2	activities, including to—
3	"(I) carry out production projects
4	for value-added food products;
5	"(II) provide working capital for
6	general operational costs of the local
7	agricultural business project;
8	"(III) purchase project-related
9	equipment;
10	"(IV) purchase seeds, plants, and
11	fruit or nut trees;
12	"(V) purchase livestock, poultry,
13	and breeding stock;
14	"(VI) construct and maintain ir-
15	rigation systems;
16	"(VII) construct buildings (in-

"(IX) carry out any other activ-
ity that the Secretary determines is
necessary to carry out this subsection.
"(iii) Priority.—In making loans,
microentrepreneurial development organi-
zations shall give priority to local agricul-
tural business projects that are operated
by local food entrepreneurs who—
"(I) are qualified beginning
farmers or ranchers or socially dis-
advantaged farmers or ranchers;
"(II) will produce locally or re-
gionally produced food to supply un-
derserved communities; or
"(III) will grow or raise locally or
regionally produced food to supply
schools or other institutions.
"(iv) Secretarial approval; guar-
ANTEE.—
"(I) APPROVAL.—A microentre-
preneurial development organization
may make a loan to a local food entre-
preneur if the Secretary determines
that the loan complies with the re-
quirements under this section.

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1	"(II) LOAN GUARANTEE.—The
2	Secretary shall guarantee not more
3	than 85 percent of the principal and
4	interest on each loan approved under
5	subclause (I).
6	"(v) Reservation of funds.—For
7	each of fiscal years 2012 through 2017,
8	the Secretary shall reserve not less than 10
9	percent of the total amount made available
10	to carry out this subsection until April 1 of
11	the fiscal year.
