

Subtitle A—Nutrition

Sec. 10102. Modifications to SNAP Work Requirements for Able-Bodied Adults.

- Aligns SNAP work requirements with Medicaid work requirements by including parents and guardians of children at or over 14 years of age and exempting individuals who are Indians, Urban Indians, California Indians, and other Indians who are eligible for the Indian Health Services.

Sec. 10105. Matching Funds Requirements.

- Revises which fiscal year payment error rate is utilized as the basis for calculating a State's match. For FY28, the first year of the matching funds requirement, a State may elect either the FY25 or FY26 payment error rate to calculate its match. For FY29 and each fiscal year thereafter, the state match shall be calculated using the payment error rate that is three fiscal years prior.

Sec. 10108. Alien SNAP Eligibility.

- Revises the SNAP-eligible populations to include only individuals who reside in the United States and are 1) U.S. citizens or U.S. nationals; (2) aliens lawfully admitted for permanent residence as an immigrant, with exceptions; (3) aliens who have been granted the status of Cuban and Haitian entrant, and (4) individuals who are lawfully residing in the United States in accordance with the Compacts of Free Association.

Subtitle B—Forestry

Sec. 10201. Recission of Amounts for Forestry.

- Strikes non-budgetary language.

Subtitle C—Commodities

Sec. 10301. Effective Reference Price; Reference Price.

- Clarifies that the effective reference price formula enhancements within Section 10301 begin with crop year 2025 for scoring purposes.

Sec. 10310. Repayment of Marketing Loans.

- Revises Section 10310 to clarify intent.

Sec. 10314. Suspension of Permanent Price Support Authority.

- Strikes the prior Section 10314 related to Suspension of Permanent Price Support Authority due to lack of budgetary effect.

Subtitle E—Crop Insurance

Sec. 10507. Poultry Insurance Pilot Program.

- Strikes “, including Alabama, Arkansas, and Mississippi,” within Section 10507 due to lack of budgetary effect.

Subtitle F—Additional Investments in Rural America

Sec. 10601. Conservation.

- Provides a single, up-front allocation of funding rather than an annual allocation for Section 10601(d) and Section 10601(f).
