15 16 17	(a) Appropriations.—In addition to amounts otherwise available, there are appropriated, out or amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the Secretaries for fiscal year 2026, to remain available through fiscal year 2032—
18	(1) \$3,600,000,000 for activities authorized by this subtitle; and
19 20 21	(2) \$100,000,000 to provide for environmental reviews by the Secretaries necessary to satisfy the obligations of the Secretaries under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.) for fireshed management projects.
22 23	(b) Restrictions.—None of the funds made available by subsection (a) may be used for any activity—
24	(1) conducted in a wilderness area or wilderness study area;
25	(2) that includes the construction of a permanent road or motorized trail;

35 36 37 38	(2) REFORESTATION TRUST FUND.—In addition to amounts appropriated pursuant to paragraph (1), notwithstanding subsection (d) of section 303 of Public Law 96–451 (16 U.S.C. 1606a), of amounts in the Reforestation Trust Fund established by subsection (a) of that section that are not otherwise obligated, the Secretary may obligate not more than \$5.000.000 for each fiscal year to carry out this section.
