- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4(a)(2)(B) of the Food
- 4 and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2013(a)(2)(B)) is
- 5 amended—
- 6 (1) in clause (i), in the matter preceding sub-
- 7 clause (I), by striking “Subject to clause (iii), begin-
- 8 ning in fiscal year 2028” and inserting “Beginning
- 9 in fiscal year 2030”; and
- 10 (2) by striking clauses (ii) and (iii) and insert-
- 11 ing the following:

1 “(ii) DETERMINATION.—For fiscal
2 year 2030 and each fiscal year thereafter,
3 to calculate the applicable State share
4 under clause (i), the Secretary shall use
5 the payment error rate of the State for the
6 third fiscal year preceding the fiscal year
7 for which the State share is being cal-
8 culated.”.

9 (b) ADMINISTRATIVE COST-SHARING.—Section 16(a)
10 of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2025(a))
11 is amended, in the matter preceding paragraph (1)—

12 (1) by striking “2026” and inserting “2028”;
13 and

14 (2) by striking “2027” and inserting “2029”.

15 (c) EMERGENCY DESIGNATION.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amounts provided for
17 purposes of the amendments made by subsections
18 (a) and (b) are designated as an emergency require-
19 ment pursuant to section 4(g) of the Statutory Pay-
20 As-You-Go Act of 2010 (2 U.S.C. 933(g)).

21 (2) DESIGNATION IN HOUSE AND SENATE.—
22 This section is designated as being for an emergency
23 requirement pursuant to section 4001(a)(1) of S.
24 Con. Res. 14 (117th Congress), the concurrent reso-
25 lution on the budget for fiscal year 2022, and to leg-

- 1 islation establishing fiscal year 2027 budget enforce-
- 2 ment in the House of Representatives.
