1 In section 4016, strike "Section 28(b)" and inserting
2 the following:

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 28(b)

4 In section 4016, add at the end the following:

5 (2) FUNDING.—Section 28 of the Food and
6 Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2036a) is amended
7 by striking subsection (d) and inserting the fol-
8 lowing:

9 "(d) FUNDING.—

10 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Of funds made available
11 each fiscal year under section 18(a)(1), the Sec-
12 retary shall make available to each State agency to

1 carry out the nutrition education and obesity preven-
2 tion grant program under this section—

3 “(A) for fiscal year 2013, an amount equal
4 to \$5 per individual in the State enrolled in the
5 supplemental nutrition assistance program; and

6 “(B) for fiscal year 2014 and each subse-
7 quent fiscal year, the applicable amount during
8 the preceding fiscal year, as adjusted to reflect
9 any increases for the 12-month period ending
10 the preceding June 30 in the Consumer Price
11 Index for All Urban Consumers published by
12 the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the Depart-
13 ment of Labor, per individual in the State en-
14 rolled in the supplemental nutrition assistance
15 program.

16 “(2) TIMING OF DETERMINATION.—At the end
17 of each fiscal year, the Secretary shall determine the
18 total number of individuals in each State enrolled in
19 the supplemental nutrition assistance program so as
20 to determine appropriate funding levels for the com-
21 ing fiscal year.”.
